Quick Guide (v2.0)

SETUP: Step 1 - Record Introduction

Record Introduction

- 1.) Call Your New Number
- 2.) During Prompt, press * (STAR)
- 3.) Enter Pass Code chosen at Sign-Up
- 4.) Complete 3-Step Tutorial
 - Step 1: Set New Pass Code
 - Step 2: Record Your Name
 - Step 3: Record Main Greeting (this is where you record the Introduction)*

* Sample Introduction Greeting

"Thank you for calling the ABC Automated Ordering Hotline. Please have your shipping, billing & credit card information ready. You will now be asked a series of questions. After each question, slowly & clearly state your response at the tone, then press 9 to move onto the next question. This will only take a few moments, so let's begin."

SETUP: Step 2 - Record Questions

Record Questions

- 1.) Call Your Number
- 2.) During Introduction Greeting, press * (STAR)
- 3.) Enter Pass Code chosen in Step 1
- 4.) Press 4 to Record Greeting
- 5.) When asked for greeting number, enter:
 - > 101 followed by the # key (to record QUESTION 1)
 - > 102 followed by the # key (to record QUESTION 2)
 - > etc... all the way up to 108 # for QUESTION 8
- 6.) Press 1 to confirm the selected greeting number.
- 7.) Record Greeting*, then press # when finished
- 8.) Follow prompts to 'Accept' greeting, then exit.

* Sample Question Greetings

ex 1) "At the tone, please state your full name and shipping address. When finished, press 9 to move to the next question."

<u>ex 2)</u> "At the tone, please state the name and product number of the item you want. Then state the quantity you wish to order. When finished, press 9 to move to the next question."

SETUP: Step 3 - Record Salutation

Record Salutation

- 1.) Call Your Number
- 2.) During Introduction Greeting, press * (STAR)
- 3.) Enter Pass Code chosen in Step 1
- 4.) Press 4 to Record Greeting
- 5.) When asked for greeting number, enter:
 - > 109 followed by the # key (to record **SALUTATION**)

(If you use more or less than 8 questions, your salutation greeting number will not be 109. As an example: for only 5 questions, use greeting 106 for your salutation. For 9 questions, use greeting 110 for your salutation.)

- 6.) Press 1 to confirm the selected greeting number.
- 7.) Record Greeting*, then press # when finished
- 8.) Follow prompts to 'Accept' greeting, then exit.

* Sample Salutation Greeting

"Thank you! Your order is complete. Charges will appear on your credit card statement as ABC Company. Please allow 2-3 weeks for shipping & handling. We appreciate your business and hope to hear from you again soon. Thank you."

Update Any Greeting

- Re-Record Any Greeting

 1.) Call Your Number
- 2.) During Introduction Greeting, press * (STAR) and enter Pass Code
- 3.) Press 4 to Record Greeting
- 4.) When asked for greeting number, enter:
 - > 10 # (to record INTRODUCTION)
 - > 101 #, 102 #... and up (to record QUESTIONS 1, 2, 3... etc)
 - > 109 # key (to record SALUTATION)

(If you use more or less than 8 questions, your salutation greeting number will not be 109. As an example: for only 5 questions, use greeting 106 for your salutation. For 9 questions, use greeting 110 for your salutation.)

- 5.) Press 1 to confirm the selected greeting number.
- 6.) Record Greeting, then press # when finished
- 7.) Follow prompts to 'Accept' greeting, then exit.

NOTE: If you do not need all 8 questions, please contact us and we will adjust your mailbox settings.
